Since joining Structure Workshop in 2011, Leon has led a design team on a range of projects across residential, educational and commercial sectors, specifically projects with heritage, sustainability or community focus.

Notable projects include Granby Four Streets: an urban regeneration project with Turner Prize winning collective Assemble in collaboration with the Community Land Trust in Toxteth; U-Build: an affordable, modular self-building system where the simplicity of the fabrication allows people with little experience in construction to build their own home; and Pensthorpe: a multi-building masterplan, including a set of cottages and a new build playbarn.
